Regular Session:

**Fire Department**

*2026 Fire Contract for the Furnishing of Fire Protection and Emergency Services to the Unincorporated Area of Fairfield Township*

Fire Chief, Brian Alkire, presented to the Board and recommended approval of the 2026-2027 Fire Contract for the Furnishing of Fire Protection and Emergency Services to the Unincorporated Area of Fairfield Township. Chief Alkire stated that the Township will not pay to the City the total sum of \$100,000.00 or any other amount for fire protection services for the year 2026 as it did in 2025. In lieu of a payment for 2025 and 2026, the Township has agreed to assist the City with acquiring a new vehicle within 36-39 months of the execution of this agreement in the amount of \$748,060.00. Discussion ensued. Mr. Shriner moved for approval. Mrs. Murray seconded. Passed.

Jeremy Diehl, Controller, presented for Board approval of Claims in the amount of \$6,890,453.10. President Henriott asked if there were any further questions and there were none. Mr. Rody moved for approval. Mrs. Moulton seconded. Passed.

President Henriott presented to the Board and recommended approval of a Banner Request for Round the Fountain Art Fair for a banner to be hung across Columbia Street from May 12-26, 2026. Mrs. Moulton moved for approval. Mrs. Murray seconded. Passed.
