Lafayette repeated its “Five-Star” ranking with Expansion Management for its quality of life in 2007. Lafayette ranked 25th out of more than 400 “best places” evaluated by “Cities ranked and Rated.” Two more awards went to the City for its creation and restoration of parks. The Shamrock Dog Park was created within Wabash Neighborhood, the City’s first dog park. This project was recognized by the Indiana Parks and Recreation Association as “outstanding.” The renovation work that the City completed on Centennial Park in 2007 was awarded the “Pride of Centennial” award from the Historic Centennial Neighborhood Association. The park now features a sheltered picnic area, playground, and basketball courts. The City’s streetscape program was again recognized by the Indiana Arborist Association for its physical design that incorporated trees. A very significant step forward was made by the Lafayette Fire Department in 2007. The ISO classification improved from 5 to 3. Superior property protection from fires is ranked as “1.” The worst rating is 10. This improvement may mean lower fire insurance premiums across the city, saving untold dollars over time.
