

## PARK RULES

1. Parks Close at Dusk (except for approved activities).

2. Parks Are Alcohol, Tobacco, And Drug-Free Zones.

3. Help Keep Your Parks Beautiful.

- Bag and dispose of pet waste.
- Place all litter in appropriate trash containers.
- Wildlife and vegetation should not be disturbed.

4. Help Keep Your Parks Safe.

- Pets are not permitted on playgrounds.
- Adult supervision is recommended on playgrounds.
- Report all inappropriate conduct to Park Security by calling 765-491-2679 or 765-479-6109.
- Overnight parking in parking lots is prohibited.
- Kite flying is not permitted under power lines.
- Swimming, wading, boating, ice skating, and ice fishing are not permitted in parks ponds and lagoons.
- Drive and park only on roadways and in parking lots.
- Motorized vehicles are not permitted on pathways and trails.
- Fires are permitted only in grills.

For Emergencies CALL 911

5. Help Keep Your Parks Fun!

- Keep all animals leashed.
- Exercise pets on a leash no longer than 6 feet.
- Avoid loud music that disturbs others.
- Rollerblades, skateboards, bikes, and scooters are not permitted on tennis and basketball courts, or on playgrounds or shelters.

### Discharge of Firearms

11.07.010 Lafayette Municipal Code: No person shall shoot, fire, or discharge any firearms of any description; guns, air guns, air pistols, or mechanical devices that shoot or throw shot, bullets, stones, or other missiles within the city, including parks, except that this section shall not prohibit any officer of the law from discharging a firearm in the performance of such officer's official duty, nor apply to any citizen when lawfully defending such citizen's person or property from physical injury.

### TOBACCO POLICY

Smoking of cigarettes, cigars, pipes, use of other tobacco products or use of electronic smoking devices is prohibited in any public park or other public place under the control of the Lafayette Park and Recreation Board, including but not limited to all playgrounds, ball fields, zoo and aquatic facilities.



# McALLISTER RECREATION CENTER

## McAllister RECREATION CENTER



McAllister Recreation Center offers diverse programming for youth and adults from day camps, basketball, volleyball, flag football, weights and fitness, to special events, and more. The grounds feature a brand new 8,600 square foot playground. The facility also offers rooms for event rentals.

### CENTER PASS

For just \$5 per year, youth ages 15 or younger will receive a pass that grants access to the game rooms and gymnasium. Individuals ages 16 and older can utilize the gym and game rooms for the following fees:

**Daily Pass - \$2 per day**

**Monthly Pass - \$30 per month**

McAllister Recreation Center features a cardio area, free-weight area, and a fitness studio. The cardio area is located above the gymnasium bleachers, and the free-weight area is located on the opposite side of the gym. These two spaces feature state-of-the-art weight and fitness equipment. There are over 30 pieces of equipment that await McAllister guests. Rubber grip weights, bench and leg presses, treadmills, upright bikes, circuit machines and elliptical machines are just a few of the pieces of equipment you can use to get a first-rate workout!

### FLAG FOOTBALL

## MCALLISTER CAMPS

Camps are open to children ages 6-12 years. All camps run from 9:00am-4:00pm. Before care runs from 7:30-9:00am, and after care is available from 4:00-5:30pm. Camp costs include before and after care. Registration is limited, so sign up early!

## WILD BEGINNINGS

### STROLLER SAFARI

### CRITTER CLASSES

Each session includes a live animal encounter.

Get ready for some hands-on, brains-on fun. Kids will explore wildlife and nature topics through a variety of engaging activities, including STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) explorations, model-making, behind-the-scenes excursions, and encounters with several live animals each session. With this much excitement, don't be surprised if your child is too busy having fun and making friends to notice how much they've learned!

## VOLUNTEER

Join our flock and spend some quality time enhancing the lives of the Zoo animals, building skills and community connections! Volunteers provide valuable support and assistance to Zoo staff, and have an integral role in the success of our many special events.

Adults ages 18 years and older may apply for an Adult Volunteer position at any time. A background check with a state issued photo ID must be completed in person at the Zoo before your application is considered complete. Once accepted into the program, you will be invited to an upcoming Volunteer Orientation session, after which you can begin volunteering! Orientation sessions take place year-round, approximately once monthly.

The Zoo Teen program is a structured summer volunteer program designed for students ages 14-17 years old. Zoo Teens have the opportunity to work alongside Zoo staff learning about the zoo industry and the importance of wildlife conservation, while building transferable job skills such as public speaking, customer service, time management, and professional conduct. First year participants focus on customer service and engagement and learn and present a limited number of animals. Teens reselected for the program in multiple years have the opportunity to build more skills in animal care and animal handling. This is a competitive acceptance program with limited space. # COLUMBIAN PARK

A recreational oasis centrally located in Lafayette, historic Columbian Park has been the place to enjoy quality leisure time with family and friends for over a century. Whether you want to cool off at the award-winning Tropicanae Cove or observe some wildlife at the Columbian Park Zoo, you will find that Columbian Park offers a vast array of fun attractions for people of all ages!

## SIA PLAYGROUND

The innovative playground includes distinct areas specifically designed for children ranging from tots to teens and features an ADA accessible playground. The SIA Playground is located near the corner of Park and Wallace Avenues. Adult supervision is recommended. A Little Library is located near the SIA Playground, across from the Curly Q Slide sculpture.



## MEMORIAL ISLAND

Dedicated in 1949, Memorial Island is a gathering place for individuals and families to enjoy outdoor entertainment and learn about the history of Tippecanoe County's brave veterans.



## Recent Improvements

After gathering input from local veterans' groups, stakeholders, and the public, the Lafayette Parks and Recreation department was proud to unveil the Memorial Island Master Plan in 2015. Phase I, which included improvements to the existing island and the addition of new memorials, was completed in 2015. Phase II, which included new promenades, memorial plaza, some lagoon shoreline enhancements, and landscaping was completed in 2018. In 2021, work concluded on Phase III, which includes:

- New stage with new sound system, shade structures, fixed seating and lawn seating
- Addition of landmass to existing Memorial Island
- ADA accessibility throughout project area
- New pedestrian bridges
- Boardwalk near water featuring swings and ADA fishing nodes
- Lagoon shoreline improvements
- Return of pedal boats to lagoon
- Addition of geyser-style fountains
- Improved water quality in lagoon
- Addition of new landscaping throughout project areas
- Fish restocking in lagoon

Additional picnic seating and benches will be added in 2022.



## COMING SOON: NEW RESTROOM BUILDING

In fall of 2021, ground was broken on a new restroom building in Columbian Park. The building will have central air and heating and feature men's, women's, and family-style restrooms. Additional parking will be added around the building. The new facility will be located just east of the new Memorial Island amphitheater where the old Jenks Rest building was located. Anticipated substantial completion for the new building is spring of 2022.



## THE NEW LOEB STADIUM

Loeb Stadium stands on the corner of Main Street and Wallace Avenue across from the Original Frozen Custard and Arni's Pizza. The stadium overlooks historic Columbian Park with beautiful views of Tropicane Cove and the Columbian Park Zoo. The original Loeb Stadium was built in 1940. Thanks to a generous gift from Bert and June Loeb, in 1971, the stadium was named in honor of Solomon Loeb.

Dedicated in spring of 2021, the new multi-use stadium features two concession areas, three indoor suites, three outdoor party decks, retail and office space, and a state-of-the-art video board. Between lawn seating and stadium seating, the new facility features a seating capacity of approximately 2,600. The venue is a multi-use facility hosting other sporting events like soccer, community events, family movie nights, concerts, etc. The new Loeb Stadium serves as the home of the Lafayette Jefferson High School Bronchos as well as the summer collegiate team, the Lafayette Aviators. **Aviators tickets can be purchased by calling 765-464-6810 or by visiting [lafayettebaseball.com](http://lafayettebaseball.com).**

## COLUMBIAN PARK EXPRESS TRAIN

Let our train conductor take you on a fun and unique ride through Columbian Park! The freshly restored train runs, weather-permitting, during Zoo opening hours with the last ride leaving 30 minutes before the Zoo closes. Tickets are available to purchase in the Zoo Gift Shop. The Columbian Park Express is in operation during the Zoo's open season mid-April through mid-October.

## COLUMBIAN PARK CAROUSEL

Lafayette Parks and Recreation is proud to debut a new carousel in Columbian Park. The carousel will feature some of the community's favorite animals from the Columbian Park Zoo as well as horses and endangered species. The ride will be fully enclosed so that riders can enjoy the attraction in rain or shine (see image below). Construction began in summer 2020. The one-of-a-kind, wooden carousel is expected to be installed in spring 2022.



## PEDAL BOATS

Pedal boats have officially launched in the newly refurbished Columbian Park Lagoon! Tickets for pedal boat rides are available to purchase in the Zoo Gift Shop. Rides are available, weather-permitting, during defined hours (see the gift shop for seasonal schedule), with the last departure 45 minutes prior to closing. Pedal boat rides are up to 30 minutes in duration, and each boat can accommodate up to four riders. All riders under the age of 16 years must be accompanied by an adult. Must be 4 years and older to ride.

## CAT PARK AND SOCCER FIELDS

3630 McCarty Lane

In 2001, Caterpillar, Inc. teamed up with Lafayette Parks and Recreation and made plans to turn 32 acres of land into CAT Park and Soccer Fields. CAT Park contains nine soccer fields and a restroom/concession building. **COMING SOON:** an all-inclusive sports field. This new addition will feature an all-abilities sports field with poured-in place rubber surfacing, two dugouts, a covered announcer's booth, score board, and spectator seating. The special field surface material is ADA compliant and will allow participation from individuals with all levels of physical abilities. The field space will be able to host a variety of sporting events and activities including, baseball, softball, and soccer, among others. Future amenities may include concession space, restrooms, batting cage, hardscaping, landscaping, and shade sails. This project is funded in part by a CDBG (Community Development Block Group) allocation to the City of Lafayette from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

## ARMSTRONG PARK

809 Beck Lane

Armstrong Park is a beautifully landscaped park named in honor of astronaut and Purdue alumnus Neil Armstrong. Located on Lafayette's south side, the 30-acre park is a favorite destination for families. Walkers enjoy the 2/3 mile paved trail that surrounds a peaceful pond. The park has a multi-age playground featuring a musical playset, five lighted tennis courts, lighted basketball courts, three youth baseball fields, open green space and wildflower areas, and restrooms. Armstrong is also home to Castaway Bay. A 50-seat picnic shelter is available for rentals. Catch and release fishing is permitted on site; all state regulations apply.

## MUNGER PARK

3505 Greenbush Street

Munger Park (pictured right) is a 32-acre park located in the northeast portion of Lafayette. The park was named in recognition of a generous gift from Thomas and Alice Munger. It features a pond, one-mile paved trail, multi-age playground, grills, open green space, wildflower areas, and restrooms. A 100-seat picnic shelter is available for rent. Catch and release fishing is permitted on site; all state regulations apply.



## CROSSER SPORTS COMPLEX

2200 Breckenridge Street

The 15-acre Crosser Sports Complex (pictured above) opened in the summer of 2020. The park, located on Lafayette's south side, features four competition-sized, lighted girls' softball fields, a restroom/concession/press box building, playground, paved trail surrounding the park, and parking. Crosser Sports Complex is the new home of Lafayette Girls Softball League. This park was made possible by the Scheumann Family Foundation, Westport Homes, Tempest Homes, Crosser Family Foundation, Spartan Trail Foundation, and River City Church, among other community partners.



# COMMUNITY PARKS

## MURDOCK PARK

2100 Cason Street

Murdock Park occupies 39 acres of urban forest. Featured is a 0.52-mile interpretive trail that allows visitors to identify nearly 40 varieties of trees located within the park. The sled run is a favorite wintertime attraction in Lafayette, entertaining kids and adults alike. Katy's Cabin provides sled rentals, hot chocolate, and concessions. A snow machine ensures that the perfect amount of white powder is available when cold temperatures prevail. Three consecutive days of freezing temperatures must occur before snow is made. Other attractions include tot and multi-age playgrounds, a redesigned 18-hole disc golf course, Brian Cardinal basketball court, grills, restrooms, and picnic areas. Two 50-seat picnic shelters are available to rent. In 2022, Murdock Park is set to receive a new picnic shelter and play equipment.

## MCCAW PARK

3745 Union Street

Named in recognition of a generous gift from Bill and Michele McCaw in 1996, this popular park is located on the east side of Lafayette. The 26-acre site boasts a state-of-the-art playground, three lighted and newly renovated youth baseball fields, grills, open green space and wildflower areas, and restrooms. McCaw Park is also home to the state's largest outdoor pickleball facility. Two 30-seat picnic shelters are available to rent.

## LYBOULT SPORTS PARK

1300 Canal Road

Named in honor of former Parks Superintendent Sam Lybault, this 52-acre park is located north of the Harrison Street bridge. Attractions include three lighted softball fields, horseshoe complex, basketball court, picnic areas, and portions of the Wabash Heritage Trail. Public restrooms are available on site.

## MCALLISTER PARK

North 9th Street

McAllister Park is named in recognition of the many generous contributions made by A.J. and Dorothy McAllister to the Lafayette Parks system. The scenic 280-acre park is located along the banks of the Wabash River. McAllister Park contains open green space, a model airplane strip, two disc golf courses, and a portion of the Wabash Heritage Trail. A bike path along North 9th Street connects the city to the park. Fishing is permitted on site; all state regulations apply.



## SHAMROCK PARK AND DOG PARK

115 Wabash Avenue

Nestled along the banks of the mighty Wabash River, Shamrock Park is located in the southwest portion of town. The 11-acre park is home to Lafayette's first dog park, which opened in July 2006. Also featured in the park are tot and multi-age playgrounds, roller hockey rink/bike polo, basketball courts, grills, and a picnic area. A 50-seat shelter is available to rent. A small boat ramp provides free access to the river. Fishing is permitted on site; all state regulations apply.

Located adjacent to the Wabash River just minutes from downtown Lafayette, this attractive, tree-lined setting provides park patrons and their dogs with three large fenced areas for all dogs and a separate fenced area for small dogs. Park users will find a safe facility to exercise and socialize their canine companions off-leash.

# NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS



## LINNWOOD PARK

1501 Greenbush Street

This 1/2-acre park is home to a newly renovated tot and multi-age playground (pictured above), basketball court, and picnic shelter. Linnwood Park received all new playground equipment in 2020!

## SIA SOUTH TIPP PARK

425 S 3rd Street

Located next to the Bauer Family Resources, SIA South Tipp Park includes two unique multi-age playgrounds, 1/2 basketball court, a picnic shelter, and amenities such as benches, drinking fountains, and misting station.

## KENNEDY PARK

2511 Sequoya Drive

Near Miami Elementary on the south side of town, this seven-acre park includes a playground, soccer field, and open green space.

## HEDGEWOOD PARK

2902 Beverly Lane

Located between Greenbush and Union Streets in the heart of the Hedgewood Neighborhood, this park provides one acre of open green space and a multi-age playground.

## NORTH DARBY PARK

14 Darby Lane

In the Vinton Neighborhood, this 0.8-acre park is home to a multi-age playground, basketball court, and open green space.

## ARLINGTON PARK

1635 Arlington Road

Located just north of Greenbush Street, this one-acre park includes a multi-age playground, picnic shelter, tennis court, basketball court, and open green space.

## STERLING HEIGHTS PARK

610 Harrington Drive

Located in the Sterling Heights subdivision on Lafayette's south side, this one-acre park features a multi-age playground, swings, and picnic shelter.



## CENTENNIAL PARK

505 6th Street

This 1/2-acre park is home to a tot and multi-age playground, 1/2 basketball court, and picnic shelter (pictured above).

## HANNA PARK

1201 N 18th Street

Across from Riggs Community Health Center, this park covers 2.2 acres. The park features unique playground equipment for 2-5 year olds and 5-12 year olds, basketball court, grill, and picnic shelter.

## STOCKTON PARK

307 Erie Street

Located at the intersection of Erie and Ferry Street within the Stockton Crossing Neighborhood, this pocket park includes green space, a shelter with picnic tables, swing, spring-rider for small children, and drinking fountain.



# RENTAL FACILITIES



## RUSH PAVILION

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, Rush Pavilion was dedicated in 1898. Rush Pavilion is the perfect setting for organizational or private group meetings. The venue can accommodate up to 50 people indoors and includes a full-service kitchen. The building features a beautiful wrap-around porch that overlooks the lagoon. Located in Columbian Park off of Scott Street, Rush Pavilion has ample parking adjacent to the building. The facility is available for rent seven days a week (excluding major holidays). Rental hours are from 11:00am - 4:00pm and 5:00pm - 10:00pm. **Fees:** \$325 for one five-hour block, or \$650 for the whole day, plus a \$150 refundable security deposit.\* Available for weekday meeting rentals Monday - Friday for \$65 per hour (2-hour minimum rental). Alcohol may be permitted on site for an additional fee, pending approval by admin office. For more information regarding additional amenities, please call (765) 807-1500.

## THE GRAND ENTRY PLAZA PERGOLA

The newly remodeled Grand Entry Plaza features a beautiful new pergola that overlooks the Columbian Park lagoon. It's the perfect backdrop for wedding ceremonies. The pergola is available for rent seven days a week (excluding major holidays). Rental hours are from 11:00am-4:00pm and 5:00pm-10:00pm. **Fees:** \$175 for one five-hour block, or \$350 for the whole day.\*

## MEMORIAL ISLAND

The newly redesigned Memorial Island is now available for rent. The island features a brand new amphitheater and state-of-the-art sound system, fixed seating, shade structures, ADA accessible fishing piers, and picturesque landscaping throughout. The facility is available for rent seven days a week (excluding major holidays). Rental hours are from 11:00am - 4:00pm and 5:00pm - 10:00 pm. **Fees:** \$250 for one five-hour block, or \$500 for the whole day, plus a \$100 refundable security deposit.\*

## DEER ISLAND

The newly renovated Deer Island is now available for rent. The beautifully landscaped island features a picnic shelter, ADA accessible fishing pier, and ample green space. The facility is available for rent seven days a week (excluding major holidays). Rental hours are from 11:00am - 4:00pm and 5:00pm - 10:00pm. **Fees:** \$200 for one five-hour block, or \$400 for the whole day.\*

The South Activity wing features a kid-friendly environment that no one can resist! The bright colors and pint-sized furniture make this section of the building perfect for children's birthday parties.




