### **Greater Lafayette Climate Action Plan Committee to Host Green Expo!**

**LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – May 26, 2022** – The Greater Lafayette Climate Action Plan (GLCAP) Committee is hosting a Green Expo on Sunday, June 5, 12 noon to 4 pm, at the Tippecanoe County Fairgrounds East Pavilion. The Expo will include a paper shred truck from Eco-Shred from 12 noon to 2 pm; various vendors from noon to 4 pm; and climate action workshops by Greeley and Hansen, the consulting firm working with GLCAP, starting at 2 pm.

The in-person workshops will include sharing of initial climate action concepts and initiatives. This will be a great opportunity for the public to weigh in and provide thoughts on how to make Greater Lafayette a more carbon-conscious and climate-resilient community for generations to come. Workshops will last roughly one hour but we encourage you to stop by and participate as long as you can. The workshop will include a formal presentation regarding the updates to the GLCAP followed by open discussion.

Vendors at the Expo will include businesses and organizations on electric vehicles and bikes, tree planting, home preparedness/winterization, organic plants, composting, land



conservation, urban gardens, sustainable farming practices, recycling, solar & electric heating/cooling, solar communities, plus much more! If you are bringing paper to be shredded, please limit three boxes per vehicle, no three-ring binders, and no CDs. Paper with staples and paper clips are fine.
