

**CITY OF LAFAYETTE & LAFAYETTE HOUSING CONSORTIUM  
FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE PROGRAM YEAR 2019 ACTION PLAN**

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Lafayette received an allocation of \$813,815 from the CARES Act. In June 2022, the City was notified of an additional allocation of \$157,382. The CARES Act allows the City of Lafayette to apply for waivers to certain statutory requirements to implement a response more quickly. The City of Lafayette will utilize waivers to allow for a shortened public comment period for the 2019 Action Plan amendment. This shortened period will be a minimum of five (5) days and will enable the City to expedite funding programs that meet community needs as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

In the fifth amendment to the Program Year 2019 Action Plan, the City proposes the following changes:

- 1) Add CDBG-CV Meals on Wheels project, funded at \$20,000
- 2) Add CDBG-CV LUM Public Facility Improvement project, funded at \$16,000
- 3) Add CDBG-CV Administration project, funded at \$31,476
- 4) Add CDBG-CV Infrastructure Improvement project, funded at \$89,906

A summary of all comments received will be included with the plan amendment submitted to the City Council. The amended plan will be submitted to HUD on or after August 2, 2022.

Approval of the amendment is scheduled to take place at the Lafayette City Council meeting on August 1, 2022, beginning at 6:00 pm in the Council Chambers on first floor of City Hall at 20 North 6<sup>th</sup> Street.
