City of Lafayette Approves Tax Abatement for GE Engine Services on \$9.4M of New Investments

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – December 5, 2023 – The Lafayette City Council has approved a tax abatement in an Economic Revitalization Area for GE Engine Service, LLC for a ten-year personal property tax abatement for \$9.4 million investment in new manufacturing equipment.

The manufacturing project will create 41 full-time permanent positions, retain 245 existing full-time, permanent positions, aside from those created or retained through the construction phase of the project.

“GE Engine Services has continued to be a valuable business partner for Lafayette and our region,” states Mayor Tony Roswarski. “We have benefitted from their investments and manufacturing workforce in our city since they opened their doors in 2015. This is a great opportunity for us to continue to build and solidify our relationship with them for a long and prosperous future between their company and our community.”
