Area of Lafayette Under a Boil Water Order Advisory Has Been Lifted!

Area is Elston Road east to Old US 231, south to Teal Road, west to Old Romney Road, back north to Elston Road.

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – June 7, 2024 – The Boil Water Order Advisory **has been lifted** for the area of Elston Road east to Old US 231; south to Teal Road; west to Old Romney Road; back north to Elston Road. See the attached map of the pink highlighted area under the Boil Water Order Advisory for clarification.

The accident was due to a contractor working on a private project for the Tippecanoe School Corporation. The Boil Water Advisory was put into place due to the disruption of water flow to residents and businesses in that area. “We appreciate everyone’s cooperation during this matter and apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.” states Steve Moore, Water Works Superintendent for the City of Lafayette. “We take this situation seriously and our top priority is the well-being and safety of our community and its residents.”

During the next few days, residents and businesses in the area may see discolored water but tests have revealed that the quality of water coming from your faucet is safe.
