City of Lafayette's 5th Street Parking Garage Completes Renovations

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – June 12, 2024 – The City of Lafayette is pleased to announce the completion of the renovation project of the 5th Street Parking Garage, located between Columbia and South Streets, just in time for this weekend's Taste of Tippecanoe. The \$1.5 million renovation project began in May of 2023 and included structural repairs, additional waterproofing to the top floor, repainting of parking lines, and new landscaping.

"We are excited that the renovation project is finished in time for many summer events and festivals downtown," states Mayor Tony Roswarski. "We realize the project took longer than anticipated but the much-needed repairs were crucial for the upkeep of the 29-year-old garage. With two parking garages fully open and on-street parking available, we invite everyone to visit downtown Lafayette this summer."

The garage was built in 1995 and holds 405 spaces with handicap parking on each level and elevator access. The garage is equipped with two electric charging stations and is open 24/7. The garage has reasonable hourly rates during the day and is FREE during nights and weekends, Monday-Friday, 6 pm to 7 am, and FREE all-day Saturday and Sunday. Hourly rates are available at www.lafayette.in.gov/1049/garage-rates and monthly parking passes are available for purchase.



During the part of the renovation period which eliminated some parking from the garage, additional parking was made available when the new 7th Street garage opened in 2023 just two blocks away for residents and guests visiting downtown. The 7th Street garage includes 468 parking spaces, and downtown on-street parking offers over 1,200 spots with restricted time allocations in some spaces.
