Utility Billing Office Moving to Temporary Location During Renovations

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – July 30, 2024 – The Utility Billing Office (UBO) located on the first floor in Lafayette’s City Hall, will be relocating temporarily due to renovations. They will vacate their current office space on Tuesday, August 6 and move to 10 North 7th Street, the old Tempest Home Office, at the corner of South and 7th Streets in Lafayette. **During the day of the move, the UBO will be closed on August 6.** It will re-open at its temporary location on Wednesday, August 7.

While the renovations are on-going, the following information will be helpful to conduct business:

- We encourage you to use UBO’s online services that are available 24-hours a day at www.Lafayette.in.gov/ubo.
- The drive-up payment drop box on the west side of City Hall will be **unavailable** during the renovation. The walk-up payment drop box inside City Hall will be available during normal business hours from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm.
- If you need to visit the temporary office location, parking is available at the 7th Street Garage or on-street parking on 7th Street in designated parking spots.

We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause. Renovations are expected to take up to 6-8 weeks. Once renovations are completed and the UBO office is back open at City Hall, we will notify the community. For any updates, please follow us on the city’s social media pages.
