GreenFest Returns June 7 with Sustainability Workshops, Local Organizations, and Family-Friendly Activities

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – June 3, 2025 – The Joint Leadership Committee for the Greater Lafayette Climate Action Plan invites community members to attend GreenFest 2025 on Saturday, June 7 from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM, a FREE, family-friendly event dedicated to environmental education and community engagement.

Held at the Big Four Depot and Riehle Plaza, GreenFest will feature nearly 20 local organizations representing a variety of environmental causes and initiatives. Attendees will have the opportunity to connect with experts, gather resources, and take actionable steps toward a more sustainable lifestyle.

A key highlight of the event will be a series of four educational workshops, covering timely and practical topics:

10:30 – 11:15 AM: Composting & Recycling

11:15 – 12:00 PM: Energy Efficiency & Renewable Energy

12:00 – 12:45 PM: Invasive Species & Stormwater Management

12:45 – 1:30 PM: Energy Democracy

In addition to the workshops, GreenFest will offer a Clothing Swap Station where attendees can explore sustainable fashion choices and learn from a local student's research into



environmentally responsible clothing choices. Attendees are encouraged to “bring 1 & take 1” of any high-quality, gently-used clothing items.

GreenFest will also feature a Kids Eco-Zone, which will include educational coloring and interactive activities tailored for young participants.

“We’re excited to bring the community together again for a day focused on learning, sharing, and taking positive action for the planet,” said Halee Griffey, City of Lafayette Climate and Resilience Manager. “GreenFest is a great way to engage with local efforts, gain valuable knowledge, and participate in fun, family-friendly activities—all while advancing our community’s shared goals for sustainability.”
