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City of Lafayette Announces Approval of Funding for Programs Supporting Lafayette Transitional Housing Center - Homeless Services Program

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – December 11, 2025 – The City of Lafayette has approved funding for two programs at LTHC Homeless Services. One award will be a \$30,785 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) award, administered by the Lafayette Housing Authority (LHA), to provide operating expenses for a case manager position to deliver counseling assessments and other basic services to support homeless individuals in Lafayette.

The second award from the American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) in the amount of \$600,000, administered by the LHA, to create two additional Tenant Support Coordinator positions to more effectively serve all four HOME-ARP Qualifying Populations. General responsibilities include providing housing support, life skills coaching, and resource coordination services to those who qualify under the HOME-ARP four Qualified Populations, and to individuals in Permanent Supportive Housing.

“LTHC Homeless Services continues to be a critical partner in our community’s efforts to ensure every resident has the opportunity to find stability, safety, and hope,” said Mayor Tony Roswarski. “These two funding awards will allow LTHC to expand its counseling staff,



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strengthening the individualized support that helps people break the cycle of homelessness. I am proud that we can invest in work that not only meets immediate needs but also builds long-term pathways to independence and well-being. This is a meaningful step forward for the individuals LTHC serves and for the future of our city.”

“LTHC Homeless Services is deeply grateful for this funding,” states Jenfer Layton, President/CEO at LTHC. “These investments over the next few years strengthen our community’s safety net and ensures that individuals and families facing housing instability receive the ongoing support they need to remain housed. With these funds, we will provide dedicated tenant support coordination that helps prevent evictions, stabilize households, and promote long-term housing success.”
