Park East Boulevard Opens from State Road 26 to State Road 38 *Boulevard provides new north-south route through Lafayette.*

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – December 23, 2025 – The City of Lafayette is pleased to announce that Park East Boulevard will open to traffic at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 23, marking a major milestone in a long-anticipated transportation project.

Park East Boulevard is now open from State Road 26 to State Road 38, creating a new north-south arterial route through the city. This new corridor is expected to significantly improve traffic flow and reduce congestion on Creasy Lane, Veterans Memorial Parkway, and Sagamore Parkway.

While the roadway will be fully open to traffic, final asphalt paving and landscaping will be completed next spring as weather conditions allow.

“This is a project our community has been planning for many years,” states Mayor Tony Roswarski. “Opening Park East Boulevard provides a critical new north-south connection, improves safety and efficiency for drivers, and helps relieve pressure on some of our busiest corridors. It’s another important investment in Lafayette’s future for continued growth and mobility.”
