City of Lafayette Reminds Residents of Trash and Recycling Pickup Times for Presidents Day Holiday

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – February 17, 2026 – The City of Lafayette Sanitation and Recycling Department is sending a friendly reminder of the updated 2026 trash and recycling pickup times for the Presidents Day holiday. Under the new schedule, residential trash and recycling routes will begin on designated days **AFTER** city-recognized holidays.

Presidents Day holiday was yesterday, Monday, February 16, so Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday collection will be delayed **BY ONE DAY** and Friday will still be collected as scheduled. (Thursday and Friday schedule will be collected on Friday).

Residents are reminded to have their trash and recycling totes placed at the curb by 6 am on affected pickup days to ensure collection. As a reminder, totes **MUST** be 3 feet from any obstruction (i.e. mailbox, vehicle, pole, tree), have 2 feet of space in between them, and **MUST** have a clear path from the curb to the street (not behind vehicles). Totes will not be emptied if the pickup instructions are not followed. The city will continue to share reminders and updates through its website and social media channels as holiday schedules approach.
